PRIVACY POLICY

- 1. The website does not automatically collect any information except for information found in cookies.
- 2. Cookie files (so-called cookies) are computer data, in particular text files, that are stored on the Website User's terminal device and used for browsing the Website. A cookie usually contains the name of the web page of its origin, the time of its storage on the terminal device, and a unique number.
- 3. The entity that transfers cookies to the Website User's terminal device and has access to them is the Website operator **NOVA Technologie Obiektowe sp.j.** with its registered office at **ul. Grochowska 42, 04-282 Warszawa, Poland.**
- 4. Cookie files are used in order to:
- a) Customize the contents of the Website to the User's preferences and optimize the use of web pages; in particular, cookie files allow the recognition of the Website User's device and correct display of the web page, in line with his or her individual needs;
- b) Create statistics that allow one to better understand how Website Users use the web pages and thereby enhance the structure and contents of such pages;
- c) Maintain the session of the Website User (after log-in) so that he/she does not have to enter his/her login and password on each sub-page of the Website;
- d) Display, using Google AdWords, targeted advertisements for persons who visited the Website;
- e) Automate marketing processes, such as analysis of traffic on the site, automatic e-mailing of advertisements, etc.
- 5. The Website uses two basic types of cookies, i.e. session cookies and persistent cookies. Session cookies are temporary files stored on the User's terminal device until he/she logs off, leaves the web page or shuts down the software (web browser). Persistent cookies are stored on the User's terminal device for a length of time specified in the cookie file parameters or until the User removes them.
- 6. The Website uses the following types of cookies:
- a) Strictly necessary cookies that make it possible to use services offered on the Website, e.g. authentication cookies for services that require authentication within the Website;
- b) Security cookies employed in order to detect abuse of authentication within the Website;
- c) Performance cookies that allow the collection of information about how the Website pages are used;
- d) Functional cookies that are used to store User-selected settings and personalize the User interface using the appropriate language, User region, font size, website layout, etc.;
- e) Advertising cookies that allow the providing of the User with advertising content better adjusted to his or her interests.
- 7. In many cases, software used for navigating internet pages (web browser) is by default set to store cookies on the User's terminal device. Website Users can change cookie-related settings at any time. In particular, it is possible to change these settings so as to disable automatic handling of cookie files in the internet browser or to inform about each case of storage on the Website User's device. Detailed information regarding options and methods of handling of cookie files is available in the software settings (of the web browser).
- 8. The Website Operator informs Website Users that restrictions regarding the use of cookie files may have an impact on certain functionalities available on the Website pages.
- 9. Cookie files stored on the Website User's terminal device may also be used by advertisers and partners cooperating with the Website Operator.
